## When is the initial inventory due?

The due date is October 16, 2024.

#### Can service lines be classified as non-lead based on install/build date?

Under Montana rule, lead was banned Dec 31, 1987; therefore, anything constructed on or after January 1st, 1988, is considered lead free. Materials should be noted as "Non-Lead – Other" in the inventory unless actual material is known

## How are lead goosenecks considered for service line definitions?

Lead goosenecks are NOT considered a source of lead in the definitions of lead service lines or galvanized requiring replacement.

# Can water sampling and predictive modeling be used to classify service line materials?

MDEQ should be consulted prior to using either predictive modeling or water sampling for verification.

#### What are the differences between the CWS and NTNCWS templates?

The NTNCWS template only has a single service line material classification (e.g. not separate portions)
